Public Consultation on
“The Real Estate (Brokers & Salesmen)
Licensing Ordinance, 2004”

The Ministry of Finance, Investment & Trade hereby recirculates the Real Estate (Brokers & Salesmen) Licensing Ordinance 2004 (hereinafter the Ordinance).

It should be noted that this Ordinance came into force on 26th October, 2004. The purpose of the Ordinance is to regulate and make provision for the licensing of Real Estate Brokers and Salesmen within the Turks & Caicos Islands.

UPDATE:

The Ministry of Finance commenced virtual consultations with the public on January 30, 2024. The virtual consultation previously scheduled for today, January 31, 2024 is hereby cancelled.

However, please note that the virtual consultations will resume this Thursday and Friday (February 1st and 2nd, 2024) at 6.00 pm. This public consultation is intended to raise awareness on the legal criteria for becoming a real estate broker/agent in the Turks and Caicos Islands and the sanctions and penalties for non-compliance.
